PURPOSE:

- To reduce hepatitis C virus (HCV) morbidity and mortality among low-income, underinsured, or uninsured racial and ethnic minorities living with HIV in the United States.
- To support the expansion of HCV prevention (including education), testing, care (including preventive health care), and treatment capacity

ELIGIBILITY:

- Any PD/PI with the skills, knowledge, and resources necessary to carry out the proposed research is invited to work with her/his institution to develop an application for support. Individuals from underrepresented racial and ethnic groups, as well as individuals with disabilities, are always encouraged to apply for HRSA support.

BUDGET AND PROJECT PERIOD:

- Award Budget: up to \$2,500,000, total per year
