PURPOSE:

- To fund research on HIV-associated cancers in low- and middle-income countries (LMICs) through collaborative efforts between investigators in United States (U.S.) and investigators in LMICs
- To provide the opportunity for enhancement of research capacity of LMIC institutions with the ultimate goal of such institutions developing progressively as independent competitive research centers
- To generate research collaborations, exchange knowledge and experiences within and across programs in these consortia and with [Sub-Saharan African Collaborative HIV and Cancer Consortia](#) , so that they can potentially develop into a global collaborative network for HIV and cancer research

ELIGIBILITY:

- Any individual(s) with the skills, knowledge, and resources necessary to carry out the proposed research as the Program Director(s)/Principal Investigator(s) (PD(s)/PI(s)) is invited to work with his/her organization to develop an application for support. Individuals from underrepresented racial and ethnic groups as well as individuals with disabilities are always encouraged to apply for NIH support.

BUDGET AND PROJECT PERIOD:

- Award Budget: up to \$600,000, total costs per year
 - UCSF indirect cost policy will apply except for non-federal entities.
- Project Period: limited to 5 years
