- To increase the availability and accessibility of high quality, comprehensive HIV prevention, care, and treatment services for key and priority populations in select priority geographic areas to advance the Ethiopia's goal of achieving the UNAIDS 90-90-90 targets and reach epidemic control
- To strengthen the enabling environment to facilitate access to comprehensive HIV services for key and priority populations and improve evidence-based decision-making through planning, monitoring, and evaluation.

- Any individual(s) with the skills, knowledge, and resources necessary to carry out the proposed research is invited to work with his/her organization to develop an application for support. Individuals from underrepresented racial and ethnic groups as well as individuals with disabilities are always encouraged to apply

BUDGET AND PROJECT PERIOD:

- Award Budget: \$65,100,000 total costs
 - UCSF indirect cost policy will apply except for non-federal entities.
- Project Period: limited to 5 years
