PURPOSE:

- To invite proposals for the acquisition and deployment of a High Performance Computing (HPC) system, called the Phase 1 system, with the option of a possible future upgrade to a leadership-class computing facility. The Phase 1 system will serve two important and complementary purposes:
 - It will serve as a robust, well-balanced, and forward-looking computational asset for a broad range of research topics for which advances in fundamental understanding require the most extreme computational and data analysis capabilities; and
 - o It will serve as an evaluation platform for testing and demonstrating the feasibility of an upgrade to a leadership-class facility five years following deployment.

ELIGIBILITY:

- An individual may be the PI or co-PI on no more than one proposal that responds to this solicitation. There is no limit on the number of proposals with which an individual may be associated in other capacities.
- Additionally, PIs or co-PIs are expected to commit at least 50% time to this activity.

BUDGET AND PROJECT PERIOD:

- Award Budget: up to \$60,000,000 total costs
 - o UCSF indirect cost policy will apply except for non-federal entities.
- Project Period: limited to 5 years
