WHAT: Hyundai Hope on Wheels Young Investigator Grant

PURPOSE:

- To provide funding for investigators, whose research project is likely to have a significant impact on improving the understanding of the biology of childhood cancer and/or developing novel diagnostic, prognostic and therapeutic approaches for pediatric malignancies.
- Projects to be funded by this program will be those that pursue innovative research that is translational in nature, that is, has the potential to impact childhood cancer diagnosis and treatment.

PLEASE NOTE THE EXTREMELY TIGHT TIMELINE FOR THIS OPPORTUNITY (see due dates below).

ELIGIBILITY:

- PI must be either:
 - An MD/physician who is currently in their 3rd or 4th year of an accredited pediatric hematology-oncology fellowship training program and involved in pediatric cancer research; or
 - A pediatric oncologist/MD, in their initial academic appointment, within 6 years from completion of fellowship training, and involved in pediatric cancer research
- No investigator can have two Hyundai Hope on Wheels awards active at the same time
- Clinical research studies or medical trials are not eligible for consideration

BUDGET AND PROJECT PERIOD:

- \$150,000
 - Indirect costs not allowed
- Project period: 2 years
