PURPOSE:

- To aggregate, analyze and visualize all participant data and samples and to provide scientific, infrastructure and administrative support for the entire Kidney Precision Medicine Project (KPMP).
- The Central Hub (CH) will collaborate with the KPMP Recruitment Sites and Tissue Interrogation Sites to obtain and evaluate kidney biopsies from participants with acute kidney injury or chronic kidney disease, create a kidney tissue atlas, define disease subgroups, and identify cells, pathways and targets for novel therapies.

ELIGIBILITY:

- Any individual(s) with the skills, knowledge, and resources necessary to carry out the proposed research as the Program Director(s)/Principal Investigator(s) (PD(s)/PI(s)) is invited to work with his/her organization to develop an application for support. Individuals from underrepresented racial and ethnic groups as well as individuals with disabilities are always encouraged to apply for NIH support.

BUDGET AND PROJECT PERIOD:

- Award Budget: Approximately \$1,700,000 direct costs per year (excluding opportunity pool).
 - Applicants may ask for \$1,000,000 or more per year for the opportunity pool.
 - UCSF indirect cost policy will apply except for non-federal entities.
- Project Period: limited to 5 years
