**WHAT:** William T. Grant Foundation Scholars Program

#### PURPOSE:

- To support career development for promising early-career researchers
- To fund five-year research and mentoring plans that significantly expand junior researchers' expertise in new disciplines, methods, and content areas
- To fund research focused on youth ages 5 to 25 in the United States
- To fund research that increases our understanding of:
  - programs, policies, and practices that reduce inequality in youth outcomes, and
  - strategies to improve the use of research evidence in ways that benefit youth

#### ELIGIBILITY:

- Employed in a career-ladder position
- Award may not be used as post-doctoral fellowship
- Have received terminal degree within 7 years of submitting application to sponsor
  - For PhDs: 7 years calculated from date doctoral degree conferred
  - For MDs: 7 years calculated from date completed first residency
- Applicants outside the US are eligible

#### BUDGET AND PROJECT PERIOD:

- Award amount: \$350,000
  - UCSF indirect cost policy will apply except for non-federal entities
- Project period: 5 years

**NUMBER OF APPLICATIONS:** 4, one from each School

#### DUE DATES:

- **Internal: 10am**, Friday, March 17<sup>th</sup>, 2017. If multiple groups submit an LOI, a pre-application will be due April 7, 2017.
- **Please note PIs may submit directly to the LSP; RMS does not get involved unless and until you are nominated**
- Sponsor: Thursday, July 6, 2017
