WHAT: Breast Cancer Alliance (https://breastcanceralliance.org/how-to-apply)

PURPOSE:

- Young Investigator Grant:
 - To encourage a commitment to breast cancer research by advancing the careers of young researchers who do not yet have their own major grant support but who design and conduct their own independent projects in breast cancer research.

• Exceptional Project Grant:

• To recognize creative, unique and innovative breast cancer research.

ELIGIBILITY:

- Young Investigator Grant:
 - Clinical doctors and research scientists, including postdocs, who are in the early stages of their careers and whose current proposal is focused on breast cancer.
 - Applicants must:
 - Not have held a tenure-track faculty or tenure-track research position for more than four years following completion of their training, as of March 1, 2024.
 - Not have been a principal investigator on an NIH R01 or equivalent national/international non-mentored award
 - Dedicate at least 50% of their work effort to research.
- Exceptional Project Grant:
 - Clinical doctors and research scientists at any stage of their careers, including postdocs, whose current proposal is focused on breast cancer.

BUDGET AND PROJECT PERIOD:

- Young Investigator Grant:
 - Award budget: \$125,000 total costs
 - Project period: 2 years
- Exceptional Project Grant:
 - Award budget: \$100,000 total costs
 - Project period: 1 year
- Indirect costs must be limited to 8% of total direct costs.

NUMBER OF APPLICATIONS UCSF MAY SUBMIT: 2 for Young Investigator Grant and 2 for Exceptional Project Grant
