WHAT: Brain Research Foundation Scientific Innovations Award (https://www.thebrf.org/wp-content/uploads/2025/04/2026_SIA_Guidelines.pdf)

PURPOSE:

- To provide funding for innovative science in both basic and clinical neuroscience.
- To support creative, exploratory, cutting-edge research in well-established research laboratories, under the direction of established investigators.
- Funding is to be directed at projects that may be too innovative and speculative for traditional funding sources but still have a high likelihood of producing important findings.
 This should be a unique project for senior investigators who are encouraged to stretch their imagination into areas that can substantially change an area of research. Preference is given to research projects that will likely lead to successful grant applications with NIH and other public and private funding entities.

ELIGIBILITY:

- Applicants must:
 - Be a full-time associate professor/full professor working in neuroscience, neurology, neurobiology, physiology, psychiatry, psychology, or related disciplines, proposing scientific projects with a focus on brain health and disease, including cancer.
 - Current major NIH or other peer-reviewed funding is preferred but evidence of such funding in the past three years is essential.
 - Have evidence of current major NIH or other peer-reviewed funding in the past three years; current funding is preferred.
 - Propose a new research project that is not funded by other sources and is related to
 either normal human brain development or specifically identified disease states this
 includes molecular and clinical neuroscience, as well as studies of neural, sensory,
 motor, cognitive, behavioral and emotional functioning in health and disease.
- Applicants must not:
 - o Be an assistant professor, professor emeritus, research associate professor, or part-time faculty member.
 - Have received the BRF Scientific Innovations Award within the past five years, have BRF funding that will overlap this grant period, or have been awarded prior BRF funding but failed to submit scientific and financial reports at the end of their grant period.
 - o Be a member, or close relative of a member, of the BRF Scientific Review Committee.

BUDGET AND PROJECT PERIOD:

Award Budget: \$75,000 direct costs per year

Project Period: 2 years
