PURPOSE:

• The Burroughs Wellcome Fund announces the Climate + Health Excellence (CHEX) Centers award. This new institutional research and training opportunity aims to bridge gaps between fields crucial for understanding and mitigating the impacts of climate change on human health. The grant supports innovative research to define health impacts, develop interventions, translate discovery science into practical applications, and enhance public understanding of Climate + Health. The goal is to help Centers of Excellence achieve strategic goals by fostering stable collaborations between people, departments, and institutions.

ELIGIBILITY:

- Must maintain a full-time appointment within the sponsoring institution.
- Must have institutionally committed laboratory and office space adequate to perform the proposed research.

- If the nominee is a PhD, at least one collaborator must be actively engaged in practicing medicine, preferably related to climate and health.
- Any individual(s) with the skills, knowledge, and resources necessary to carry out the proposed research as the Program Director(s)/Principal Investigator(s) (PD(s)/PI(s)) is invited to work with their organization to develop an application for support. Individuals from underrepresented racial and ethnic groups as well as individuals with disabilities are always encouraged to apply.

BUDGET AND PROJECT PERIOD:

- Award budget: \$2,000,000
- Project Period: 5 years
