WHAT: NIH NICHD Neonatal Research Network (NRN)

PURPOSE:

- To improve healthcare and outcomes for newborns. This includes finding ways to improve the chances for survival without neurodevelopmental impairment for infants born premature, low-birth weight, or with other serious conditions.
- To conduct definitive, rigorous, and reproducible, multi-site clinical trials and observational studies in newborns and lactating people, providing evidence to guide neonatology, pediatric pharmacology, and lactation clinical practice. Study designs may include, but are not limited to: investigational new drug or device, comparative effectiveness, and management trials; biomarker validation studies that are immediately preparatory to trials; and observational studies. Studies may assess both short-term (clinical) and long-term infant and child outcomes (i.e., up to school age).
- **Data Coordinating Center:** To develop, implement, and analyze results for Network protocols, especially providing biostatistical expertise, computer programming, and project management to design protocols, develop statistical analysis plans, develop data management systems, manage Network study funds, monitor data integrity and study safety, and work with study investigators to analyze, and publish study results.
- **Clinical Centers:** To develop and implement Network protocols, recruit study participants, implement study interventions, conduct required follow-up examinations, and work together to publish study results. CC's may also be able to engage in training opportunities.

ELIGIBILITY:

- Any individual(s) with the skills, knowledge, and resources necessary to carry out the proposed research as the Program Director(s)/Principal Investigator(s) (PD(s)/PI(s)) is invited to work with his/her organization to develop an application for support. Individuals from underrepresented racial and ethnic groups as well as individuals with disabilities are always encouraged to apply.

BUDGET AND PROJECT PERIOD:

- Award Budget:
 - Data Coordinating Center: Application budgets are not limited but need to reflect the actual needs of the proposed project. NIH intends to commit an estimated total of \$3,100,000 for the base budget to fund one award, for fiscal year 2023. Future year amounts will depend on funding availability.
 - Clinical Centers: up to \$220,000 direct costs per year
 - UCSF indirect cost policy will apply except for non-federal entities.

- Project Period: up to 7 years
