WHAT: NIH ORIP Biomedical Research Facilities (C06 Clinical Trial Not Allowed) PAR-25-061 (<u>https://grants.nih.gov/grants/guide/pa-files/PAR-25-</u>061.html# Section%20III.%20Eligibility%20Information)

PURPOSE:

- To modernize existing or construct new biomedical research facilities.
- Each project is expected to produce substantial long-term improvements to the institutional research infrastructure. Intended projects are the construction or modernization of core facilities and the development of other shared research infrastructure serving an institution-wide research community with broad impact on biomedical research.

ELIGIBILITY:

- Multiple PDs/PIs are not allowed.
- The PD/PI should have the appropriate standing in the institutional administration and the research community to lead and oversee the project.

BUDGET AND PROJECT PERIOD:

- Award Budget: Application budgets are not limited, but need to reflect the actual needs of the proposed project. The maximum award budget is \$8,000,000. Applications with budget less than \$2,000,000 will not be considered. Since the scope of different projects will vary it is anticipated that the size of the awards will vary.
 - UCSF indirect cost policy will apply except for non-federal entities.
- Project Period: The total project period may not exceed five years. Funds will be provided in a single award with up to 60-month budget and project period.

NUMBER OF APPLICATIONS UCSF MAY SUBMIT: 1

Note that UCSF leadership will participate in the selection of the nominee to ensure institutional alignment with the chosen project.

- PIs submit directly to the LSP; RMS does not get involved unless and until you are nominated.
