

Cancer Early Detection/Interception/Prevention RFA

Overview

Through a generous philanthropic gift, we are soliciting applications for funding for research into Early Detection, Interception, or Prevention of cancer in people genetically predisposed to cancer.

Applications should focus on at least one of these areas and describe innovative approaches that have the potential to have clinical impact.

Eligibility

This RFA is open to any UCSF researchers with faculty status.

Award Amount and Terms

\$200,000 (total) for one to two years. A second year is contingent upon receipt of a satisfactory progress report. Budgets should not include indirect costs.

Review Criteria

Applications not meeting the specified subject of the RFA will be rejected. Valid applications will be peer reviewed.
